Mood: 70', 80', 90' and everyday life.

10/20 photos in high resolution Formats: 135 or 120 film format digitalised in .jpg via WeTransfer (preview in PDF is required) About you and credits: Please write your bio, a link of your website, social links and all necessary credits

Equipment: Please insert the equipment that has been used, including film and camera If you want you can write an anecdote or a story related to the photos you've taken

Contributors & writers are invited to send their contribution

Everything about photography, art, fashion and music.

We also encourage emerging or established film makers to send us a video of up to 1 minute in length. A video of the shooting or related to the photos you sent. The video will be uploaded to our Youtube channel together with the photographic series.

All photos and videos are welcome, but be sure to submit material that reflects the aesthetic of PARANOIA. In any case, PARANOIA reserves the right to choose and publish images or complete series closer to its concept and we can't guarantee that each series will be published. We try to answer everyone, but if we don't respond within two weeks, you can consider your request not accepted (read the Disclaimer below before sending any messages).

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IMAGE FORMATTING

All images submitted to PARANOIA should follow these guidelines. If these guidelines are not followed your images will not be eligible.

- 1. Size your photo appropriately. We recommend 1800px on the longest edge, and saved 72dpi/ppi
- 2. **Important** name your file as follows: title_cameraandlens_artistname.jpg. If your submission does not contain an artist's name it cannot be used.
- 3. Your file must be a jpeg under 20MB. If your image does not comply, it will not be considered.
- **4. Only submit ONE (1) image** unless the curator has specifically stated that you may submit more than one.
- 5. Please do not submit the same image to more than one open stream or an image that has recently been featured.

DISCLAIMER: By submitting the images the photographer accepts and assigns the right for PARANOIA to publish and use the same on its own website www.paranoia-mag.com and social media platforms such as Facebook and Instagram, as well as any other medium or platform.
